


Fall 2019 National Concrete Consortium Highlights

Kalispell, Montana – September 10-12, 2019



The 2½-day fall meeting of the National Concrete Consortium (NC²), hosted by the Montana DOT, brought together the expertise and experience of 170 attendees from: 33 DOTs (69 individuals), the Illinois Tollway, FHWA, academia, and industry, in an excellent event focused on improving concrete performance and structural concrete applications. Dan Miller, Cement and Concrete Engineer from the Ohio Department of Transportation, is the current chairperson. The general session consisted of 19 topics presented by representatives from five state agencies, four from FHWA, one from academia, one from the Bureau of Reclamation, and ten from the industry sector.
